

## The Greg Peter Memorial Fund

Greg Peter, a lifelong Rochester resident, was widely known throughout the community. He was the owner of Air-Tec and co-owner of Mid-West Sheet Metal. Greg was also famous in the area for his musical talents. Fans from all over northern Indiana would gather to hear concerts played by Brandy Creek, Treated and Released, and Undercover Blues Band, all in which Greg sang and played bass guitar.



During his spare time, Greg loved doing home restoration projects with his family and reading. He also enjoyed cooking for his wife and children whenever he got the chance.

After his sudden passing in 2008, Greg's wife, Julie, wanted to do something to keep his memory alive. She chose to create a scholarship fund in his name and held an event at the Rochester Moose Lodge to help collect the \$5,000 needed to start Greg's fund. Through the support of the community, the event raised an astonishing \$8,693.75.

The Greg Peter Memorial Fund was established in 2010 and supports scholarships designed for graduates of Rochester Community High School who will pursue a degree in the arts and/or HVAC education. Recipients must also show an involvement in community activities.

Julie hopes that Greg's memory will live forever and that students who share Greg's interests will receive an extra bit of help to pursue their dreams.
