

Randy Steg Memorial Fund

Randy Steg was born at Grissom Air Force Base on April 6, 1966, the son of Richard and Jean Steg. He grew up in Peru, Indiana and graduated from Peru High School- Class of 1984.

Randy attended Indiana State University, graduating in 1988 with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminology. Upon graduation, Randy was hired by the Indianapolis Police Department where he was nominated for officer of the year.

An on duty traumatic incident forced his retirement from the Indianapolis Police Department and he returned home to Peru where he resided for the remainder of his life.

Randy suffered from post-traumatic stress disorder for many years until succumbing on May 3, 2011. Officer Steg's landmark case was the first of a kind for IPD forcing the department to revise procedures and policies subsequently helping numerous officers.

Randy was a member of Saint Charles Catholic Church. He donated his time and funds to many local charities. He enjoyed Baltimore Orioles baseball and Indianapolis Colts football. Randy was a beloved son, brother, uncle and friend.

Family and Friends have established the Randy Steg Memorial Fund to honor his memory. This fund will provide scholarships to Miami County students with collegiate plans to study in the field of Criminology/Criminal Justice.
