What We Do

The Boomerang Sisterhood draws upon the wisdom and resources of Miami County women to create a better community through charitable giving.

How

Your contribution is pooled with other members' contributions to annually grant monies to Miami County charitable projects. We direct 50 percent of the annual contributions to grants and invest the remaining 50 percent in an endowment fund at the Community Foundation. The fund will grow forever and benefit Miami County indefinitely.

Why

The needs in Miami County are so great, but together, we can make a difference.

When

The deadline to join is July 31, and the date of our annual meeting is September 26.

We want to expand our membership to "100 Women Who Care." This will raise our grant making capacity and enable us to give more each year... forever.

Make a Difference

The Boomerang Sisterhood Giving Circle meets just once annually. At the annual meeting, finalists for grants give a short presentation and members vote for the projects they wish to support. After the votes are tallied, the grants are awarded. An annual survey is also taken at the meeting to determine where members would like to see funding directed the following year. Recipients from previous years are also invited to give a report on their organization and the effects of the grant awarded to them.

Did you know?

- Only 10% of Miami County citizens have a bachelor's degree or higher.
- Miami County ranks 83 out of 92 counties for healthy behavior (smoking and obesity).
- 23% of Miami County children are not prepared for kindergarten.
- 40% of Miami County families are making less than the survival budget (where you are 1 paycheck away from falling into poverty).
