Instructions for completing the application. Application Deadline is July 5, 2019.

1. **Review the Scholarship Fund Information and Qualification pages** to see if you are eligible to apply..
2. Application should be **typed or legibly printed in ink.**
3. **Complete the Scholarship Cover Page** and mark the boxes next to all of the scholarships for which you are applying.
4. Attach all required documents.
5. Only **one official school transcript** is required. The Foundation will make additional copies as needed.
6. Provide a quality **wallet size photo** with your name on the back of the photo.
7. **Scholarship Essay Question**
 - Submit your responses on a separate sheet of plain white paper.
 - Include your name on the top left of the page and the name of the scholarship you are applying for on the top right of each page.
8. **Submit one original application and all required attachments. Do not use staples.** Use only paper clips or clamps to attach your application materials to each other. Organize your application and all required materials.
9. **Please return the application to the Northern Indiana Community Foundation** office at 227 E. 9th St., P.O, Box 807, Rochester, IN 46975. Must be in the NICF office by the July 5, 2019 deadline.

Back Home Again in Indiana Scholarship:

Specifically for Non- traditional students. A Non-Traditional Student is defined as one who did NOT begin their college immediately upon the completion of their high school career, but rather is one who graduated from high school or received their GED and delayed the entrance into college.

The fund is designed to give preference to non-traditional students who wish to further their education and/or training as a way of enhancing their employment skills.

Qualified recipients include adult students who wish to re-enter the job market, advance in their current field, or enter the job market for the first time after hardship circumstances, such as divorce, health complications involving family members, loss of employment, or other obstacles. This scholarship also supports students who are invested in their communities as well as working towards a college degree.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Live in Fulton, Miami or Starke County;
2. Non-traditional student as outlined above;
3. GPA of 2.5 or higher

Reapplication requirements:

The scholarship may be renewed, subject to the availability of sufficient funds. To reapply, interested recipients must write a letter to the committee asking to be considered for renewal along with a copy of their most current semester grades and return to the NICF office by the scholarship deadline date.
